DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IMPORTANT: Before using EVO-STIK Trowel Mastic refer to the relevant Health & Safety Data Sheet, available at www.bostik.co.uk.

PREPARATION

1. All surfaces must be clean, dry and free from dirt, dust, grease and any other contamination.

- Any loose adhering material including paint must be removed prior to the application of EVO-STIK Trowel Mastic.
- Very poroussurfaces may be lightly brushed with boiled linseed oil, which must be allowed to dry before application.

APPLICATION

- Apply EVO-STIK Trowel Mastic by either trowel or trowelling knife.
- When using EVO-STIK Trowel Mastic for fillet pointing, face width should be a minimum of 10mm with a minimum depth of 6mm, ensuring that a solid fill is achieved.
- The surface should be pointed to a smooth finish immediately after application.
- 7. Surface drying occurs within 7 days, followed by gradual drying of the cross-section.
- 8. Regular maintenance and protective treatment with a paint system is essential to achieve long-term performance.
- 9. A good quality conventional non-bituminous decorative paint system should be used and painting may be carried out when the protective skin has formed (approx. 48 hours).
- After use, flatten the surface of the mastic and replace the polythene disc, ensuring the container is properly sealed.

CLEANING

- 11. Clean tools and equipment immediately after use with white spirit.
- Hardened material can only be removed by mechanical means.
- 13. Do not use solvents to remove from hands/skin use soap and water.
